

Call for Participants: Just -A-Buck Retail Training Program



Just -A-Buck is accepting referrals to its retail training program at both Just -A-Buck stores (located in South Euclid and Parma). This hands-on training program prepares individuals with disabilities for competitive, community-based employment opportunities.

First Phase: Interested individuals participate in a 30-day trial period in which they participate in a training overview that covers all the relevant tasks related to working in a retail store.

Second Phase: After the trial period, participants have the option to choose to receive more in-depth retail training in areas where they need the most improvement or choose to seek out other training opportunities, assisted by their Support Administrator. If they choose to stay, they will be referred to job placement services and continue to train at the Just-A-Buck store for up to five months.

Completion of Training: After completion of the training program, placement in a competitive, community-based job is the expected outcome for each participant.
