



## Call for Participants: Cleveland Crops Culinary Arts Training Program

The Cleveland Crops Culinary Arts Training Program is a partnership between the Cuyahoga County Board of DD, SAW, Inc., and Lutheran Metropolitan Ministry.

### About the program:

- You will learn skills and knowledge to prepare you for a job working with food.
- Some of the instruction will be in a classroom, and some will take place in a commercial kitchen.
- This is a 6-month training program that meets 4 days/week for 6 hours each day.
- You are eligible for a \$300 training stipend. (\$150 paid at the end of three months, and \$150 paid upon your completion of the program at six months.)
- All learning materials and your uniform will be provided.
- There are no registration fees.
- You will be able to earn up to three certificates: culinary certification, ServSafe certification, and a job readiness certification.
- Employment staff will support you during the training program and help you find a job in the community after you complete the program.
