

Call for Participants Just-A-Buck Retail Training Program



Just-A-Buck is accepting referrals to its retail training program at both Just-A-Buck stores (located in South Euclid and Parma). This hands-on training program prepares individuals with disabilities for competitive, community-based employment opportunities.

First Phase: Interested individuals participate in a 60-day trial period in which they receive a training overview that covers all the relevant tasks related to working in a retail store. Individuals must be referred to Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities for career counseling in order to participate.

Second Phase: After the two month trial period, participants who have demonstrated potential for success in the retail field have the option to choose to receive more in-depth retail training in areas where they need the most improvement or choose to seek out other training opportunities, assisted by their Support Administrator or other staff. This retail training program will not exceed a total of seven months (two months for the first phase + up to five months for the second phase).

Completion of Training: After completion of the training program, individuals are referred to Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities for assistance with achieving competitive, community-based employment.
