



Staying safe in the summer

It is great to be outdoors in the summer. Staying healthy and enjoying the season means avoiding summertime health risks such as dehydration, sunburn, heat-related illness, and food poisoning.

Avoid dehydration by drinking at least eight glasses of water per day. Remember alcohol or caffeine, such as coffee, tea, or pop, can make you dehydrated.

Prevent sunburn by avoiding the sun 10am - 4pm, wearing a hat and applying sunscreen every two-three hours, or more if swimming. Sunscreen should be SPF15 or higher. It is also helpful to use lip balm with sunscreen, wear sunglasses or stay in the shade.

Be extra careful with food. Don't let it sit in the sun. Always wash your hands before eating and be sure to use clean plates and utensils. Cover food to keep away insects and discard food that has been left out of a refrigerator longer than two hours. When in doubt, throw it out.

Take additional safety measures for swimming or summer camp. Also keep in mind hot car safety. Never leave anyone in a hot vehicle for any period of time. It only takes a few minutes for someone to be at risk.
