Dear Provider,

The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) will begin posting provider compliance reports online. This will offer greater access to the public, especially families and individuals seeking or currently receiving DODD services.

Reports will be available by provider for each county in which a review was completed and will include all final citations and corresponding approved plans of correction. In the case of a newly certified provider that has not yet had a regular or special review, information for that provider will not be searchable in this feature.

- 2013 compliance reports will be available beginning April 28, 2014. The content will include final reports for regular and special reviews.
- 2014 compliance reports from January 1, 2014 to April 30, 2014 will be accessible beginning June 1, 2014 via the provider search function at: <http://providersearch.dodd.ohio.gov/>

To accomplish the posting of compliance reports, DODD has created the Provider Plan of Correction (POC) application. This application:

- Allows providers to respond to citations made during reviews by submitting plans of correction electronically and
- Enables DODD reviewers to post compliance reports to the DODD website once the plan of correction is approved.

The POC application will be piloted by DODD reviewers for selected reviews beginning May 1, 2014. Prior to using the Provider Plan of Correction application, training will be offered to providers and written instructions for accessing the application, finding reports and entering a plan of correction will be made available.

***Before using this new application, it is vital that you do the following:***

If you have not already, familiarize yourself with the DODD portal.

1. Make sure your permission to access the portal is current and that you are able to log in to the system.

2. If you need to update your permission to access the portal, use the following link to update your security affidavit.

3. If you need to reset your login or password, select “forgot password” and follow prompts.
4. Check your profile in the portal. It is vital that you maintain current contact information in the DODD system. *Make sure that your email and contact information is up to date.*
