Vice President, Allison Frazier turned the meeting over to Dr. Amber C. Gibbs, Superintendent & CEO. Dr. Gibbs gave the following announcements:

- We had a fantastic month will all the activities going on for Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month. Following is a list of some of the events/activities:
 - On March 1st we held a legislative breakfast. Individuals, families, staff, and providers were in attendance, meeting with some of our area legislators.
 - Four advocates along with Dr. Gibbs and some of our staff attended the DD Awareness and Advocacy Day at the Ohio Statehouse on March 12. Also in attendance were many advocates, families, and providers. Our sensory mobile vehicle was on hand at the event.
 - Two individuals we serve attended the National Self-Direction Conference in Baltimore, Maryland, March 14-15. Tierra Williams and Jackie Smith were selected as recipients of the scholarship fund that was established through donations given when previous Superintendent, Kelly Petty retired.
 - On March 15, the Cuyahoga County Rockets, Special Olympics basketball team played (and defeated) the Cuyahoga DD Tigers made up of members of our staff. This was a fundraiser for Harvest for Hunger and for the Rockets team, each receiving donations of \$725.
 - The Cleveland Monsters hockey team sponsored their first sensory-friendly game on March 18th. Our staff met with the Monsters staff to train them on how to welcome and include those with sensory needs.
 - On March 28th, the artists who completed the mural at Big Creek Center gathered to be recognized with a plaque at the building.
 - The Mobile Sensory Vehicle will be in attendance at the Eclipse Festival at the Cleveland Science Center on April 8th.
